Here's what you need to know

- Virginia passed a law in 2012 that allowed for documents to be notarized over live audio/video
- Much like marriage certificates and driver's licenses, there is interstate recognition (Mass resident can use a Virginia notary)
- Notarize's mission is to let anyone sign and notarize documents 24x7, from anywhere in the world

- We have the opportunity to be first






How to get your document on notarized at UPS

When you needed to get a document notarized, it usuall meant waiting in line at a bank, a FedEx or UPS, or at he Office down the street. This can be a huge hassle for sec who don't have the ability to take time off work or leave to find a notary public. And, even if you can find the time next question is always Where Can I Get Something Notary? Or even better, Where C Get Something Notarized for Free?

Your local UPS is usually the only place that might be offer cheap notary services.

How much does a notarization at UPS cost?

- · \$30 for a walk-in
- · A few dollars if you schedule an appointment





- Chat bot is programmed to collect email addresses
- About 80% of leads say "yes" they have a document right now
- Marketing sends email afterward with a link to upload their document

The results

- Almost 50% of leads are coming through support
- We've retargeted accounts we're trying to land (eg. WeWork)
- More people are getting documents notarized = \$\$\$

First Online Closing in SW Florida

- 82-year old George Trepanier, a New Hampshire resident, was selling his winter condo in Bonita Springs, Florida
- This closing was the first time integrating online closing software and title production software to streamline the process of selling a home
- James Schlimmer, the managing parter at the title company was extremely well connected to local communities, and was actually involved in helping to pass laws to make this tech possible





The Boston Globe Approach

- Prove that your first
- Humanize the story
- Make me see/feel something






The Launch Plan

- Tell local media this was history being made
- Coordinate local press to come to the actual closing
- Blog post, press release and social push
